At YDO, we develop the leaders of tomorrow by trusting Lawrence youth to be leaders, today. As they grow up in our organization, students step into roles as STEM and arts teachers and mentors for the younger YDO Kids following in their footsteps. In 2025, we hired more than 100 Lawrence youth, and they earned over \$175,000 in wages. As such, older students deepen their

application, impressive on a resume, and important in a career.

Today, the YDO alumni community is growing rapidly as more and more of these young Lawrencians transition from being YDO leaders to young professionals, including at our organization, where one-quarter of adult YDO staff are alumni of our program. 
